Incorporated in 1892, WCBA is committed to maintaining the honor and dignity of the <u>profession of law</u>, cultivating <u>social relations</u> among its members, and increasing its usefulness in promoting the due <u>administration of justice</u>.

What is WCBA?

- WCBA is a non-profit professional trade association serving 480 members (attorneys; judges are honorary members)
- 65% of attorneys in county are members (membership is voluntary)
- 80% of members have primary office addresses in Washington County
- 25% of members are women
- 20% of members have been practicing fewer than 5 years or are 38 years of age of younger

Professional Networking

WCBA provides members a forum for discussing ideas and strategies...

- Bar Association business meetings (~6/year)
- Practice area sections (Estate, Family, Criminal, Civil, Energy) and Young Lawyers' Division meet quarterly
- 10 committees to assist Bench, Bar & Public
- Annual 1-day Winter Bench Bar (attended by 80% of members); annual 3-day Summer Bench Bar (for bar members and their families)
- Nationally recognized Mentoring Program for new attorneys
- Professional leadership opportunities, including an annual Board Retreat to discuss governance issues

Continuing Legal Education

...and opportunities for sharing knowledge, improving skills, and increasing professional excellence:

- Attorneys are required to take 12 hours of Continuing Legal Education per year
- WCBA is an accredited provider of CLE and coordinates ~60 seminars/yr and two annual conferences (total attendees in 2011: 1,541)
- Member benefit: CLE offered at reduced rates for members at an average of \$21/credit (average cost in PA is \$51/credit)

Public Service Committees

WCBA's 10 committees operate to benefit the public, the justice system, the profession, and members:

- Fee Dispute Committee to mediate fee issues between clients and attorneys (violations of the Rules of Professional Conduct handled by Disciplinary Board of the Supreme Court of PA)

Referral Programs for Public

WCBA helps members build their client base and helps the public find appropriate legal resources:

- Lawyer Referral Service \$30 initial consultation fee,
 ~1,000 referrals/year
- Pro Bono/Conflict program free legal assistance for income-eligible and case-eligible clients unable to be represented by legal aid
- Modest Means program reduced fee legal assistance for eligible clients within 200% of the poverty level
- Limited Representation Custody Program free legal assistance for eligible clients within 200% of the poverty level at the first, crucial stages of custody proceedings.

Legal & Public Notices

WCBA publishes notices required by law for the benefit of the public, the legal community, and the several Courts of Washington County:

- Washington County Reports, weekly legal journal
- By subscription (\$65/yr)
- Notices include estate, commercial, corporation, Sheriff Sales, fictitious names, trial lists, judges' opinions, etc.
- Public notices posted weekly to website
- Accepts sponsors a cost-effective way to reach the legal community with services it can use
